Focus Area 1: Implementation

Goal 1: Advance and strengthen the priorities of the Ocean Resources Management Plan (ORMP) and the National Ocean Policy (NOP)

Outcomes:

- Implementation of ORMP management goals/actions that align with NOP objectives
- Development and adoption of sub-regional (Hawaiian Archipelago) and localized planning priorities to guide a Hawaii CMSP effort.



Focus Area 1: Implementation

Goal 2: Promote the use of ecosystem data and geospatial information to inform policy and decision-making

Outcomes:

- Creation of a Coastal and Marine Spatial Data Viewer
- Development and adoption of a CMSP framework for Hawaii that aligns with sub-regional and localized priorities



Focus Area 1: Implementation

Goal 3: Ensure meaningful engagement and coordination of partners and the public throughout natural and cultural resource management processes in the islands

Outcomes:

- Advancement toward the formalization of a Pacific Regional Ocean Partnership
- Development and implementation of an Outreach and Communication Strategy
- Development of a process to ensure effective consultations with science experts and Native Hawaiian cultural practitioners



Approach

Track 1a:

Support a large-scale, two-year *mauka to makai* (ridge to reef) ORMP priority implementation mapping and ecosystem restoration project in He'eia/Kaneohe Bay that directly benefits the community and environment (**ORMP/NOP Implementation Project**)

Track 1b:

Map the spatial range and intensity of key human coastal and near shore ocean uses on Hawaii and Maui islands (**Coastal Use Mapping Project**)



Approach

Track 2:

Develop a CMSP Framework for Hawaii based on a robust stakeholder and public input process (**Hawaii CMSP Framework**)

- a) Sub-regional (Hawaiian Archipelago) planning priorities
- b) Localized (island) priorities
- c) Outreach & Communication Strategy to define CMSP in Hawaii
- d) Spatial data viewing portal to house data layers
